## Nutrition Education and Physical Activity Grant (NEPA) FY19

The NEPA grant is designed to promote equitable opportunities and access to nutrition education and physical activity programming and services to all DC schools. OSSE identified five categories where schools are differentiated in current nutrition education and physical activity practices. Grant applicants must partner with at least 3 schools from Group A. While school-level data was used for determining the groups in the table below, please note that this table is neither a ranking of schools' physical activity and nutrition education programming nor a ranking of their students' health. The following are the five factors and the corresponding weights assigned to each factor:

1. Percentage of At-Risk students at a school based on data from the most recent [2017-18 School Level Enrollment Audit Report](#): **30 points**. A student is considered at-risk if eligible for any one of the following criteria – eligible for SNAP/TANF, homeless, in the foster care system, or high school student who is one or more years older than the expected age for that grade. Further breakdown of points is as follows:
  - a. 0% - 19%                      0 points
  - b. 20% - 39%                    10 points
  - c. 40% - 65%                    20 points
  - d. 70% - 100%                  30 points
  
2. Previous Grantee Status - Total number of Healthy Schools Act grants received for FY 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, and 2017-18: **30 points**. Further breakdown of points is as follows:
  - a. More than or equal to 6 grants                      5 points
  - b. 4 or 5 grants    10 points
  - c. 2 or 3 grants    20 points
  - d. 0 or 1 grant    30 points
  
3. Nutrition domain percentage scores based on the most recent administration of the Health and Physical Education Assessment (HPEA) in SY 17-18: **20 points**. Further breakdown of scores is as follows:
  - a. 80% - 100%                    5 points
  - b. 60% - 79%                      10 points
  - c. 50% - 59%                      15 points
  - d. 0% - 49%                        20 points

Please note: HPEA is administered annually at grades 5, 8, and for high schools students who are enrolled in health class. Schools that have the requisite HPEA grades but which did not administer HPEA in SY 17-18 receive 0 points on their total score. However, this

factor was not considered in the final scores for schools that did not have the requisite grades for HPEA administration.

4. Physical Activity minutes as reported in the HSA School Health Profiles of SY 17-18: **20 points**. The Healthy Schools Act of 2010 outlines the required physical education minutes per week for grades K-5 and 6-8. The Healthy Schools Act further mandates that at least 50% of physical education class time shall be devoted to physical activity. Based on mandate, the scores are calculated as follows:
- a. For grades K-5: According to the Healthy Schools Act, the required number of physical education minutes is 150 minutes per week, half of which must be devoted to physical activity. Therefore the required number of physical activity minutes is 75 minutes per week.
    - i. Greater than or equal to 75 minutes                      5 points
    - ii. 40 mins – 74 mins    10 points
    - iii. 1 mins – 39 mins    15 points
    - iv. 0 mins    20 points
  - b. For grades 6-8: According to the Healthy Schools Act, the required number of physical education minutes is 225 minutes per week, half of which must be devoted to physical activity. Therefore the required number of physical activity minutes is 113 minutes per week.
    - i. Greater than or equal to 113 minutes                      5 points
    - ii. 56 mins – 112 mins    10 points
    - iii. 1 mins – 111 mins    15 points
    - iv. 0 mins    20 points
  - c. For grades 9-12: The Healthy Schools Act does not provide a specific, mandated, number of physical education and physical activity minutes per week. Therefore, this factor was not considered for grades 9-12. For schools that include grades apart from high school grades, the average score from those grades was considered for this factor.  
**Please note:** Schools that did not complete their School Health Profiles receive a score of 0 points. However, this factor was not considered for pre-K schools as they do not have a physical education requirement in the Healthy Schools Act.
5. Percentage of students (all ages) that are chronically absent as reported in the SY16-17 Attendance Report: **10 points**. Further breakdown of score is as follows:
- a. 0% - 25%    2.5 points
  - b. 26% - 50%    5 points
  - c. 51% - 75%    7.5 points
  - d. 76% - 100%    10 points

Based on the calculations above, all schools are scored out of a total of 110 points. Any new school as of this school year was placed in Group A. All alternative schools that have any grades from PreK – 12th were also placed in Group A.
