Registration

To register, please go on the DCPS homepage (http://dcps.dc.gov) and look under "Announcements". Click on New Teacher Orientation and follow directions. Please note, registration is not transferable. You are required to show photo identification when checking in.

Administrative Premium

Participants at New Teacher Orientation will be compensated 7 hours of Administrative Premium pay, each day at \$34.00 per hour.

To qualify for Administrative Premium pay, you are required to register between 7:00am and 8:00 am on both days, and must remain at Orientation until 3:30 pm on all three days.

Program Changes

There may be late changes to scheduling or panelists. All changes will be displayed at the registration booth and/or appropriate notices will be posted at each workshop venue. Thank you for your cooperation.

Session Seating

Once a session is full, no one will be admitted. Mandated sessions are offered enough times throughout the Orientation to ensure that all participants will be able to

attend. If a session is full, you may attend any other session that has available space.

Parking

We strongly recommend Metro transportation to Orientation. The high school is located about one block from the Columbia Heights Metro Station (on the Green and Yellow lines). Parking is not allowed on most streets near Columbia Heights Education Campus. When parking, please carefully read the signs to ensure that your car does not get ticketed or towed.
