# Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM)



OSSE has adopted Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) as the new districtwide alternate science assessment for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities.

Through the DLM science consortium, OSSE will work with members from 14 states and higher education partner organizations to continue to collaboratively develop this alternate science assessment.



# DLM Test Administration

The DLM Science Alternate assessment is an on-demand computer-based assessment that replaces the DC Science Alternate portfolio assessment and will be administered in spring 2019.

DLM will be administered to students in grades **5, 8, and high school Biology** who are eligible for alternate assessment participation.

The DLM testing window will be **March 18 – May 3, 2019**. This is the same testing window as the MSAA.



# DLM Content and Accessibility

DLM is based on NGSS alternate achievement standards (AA-AAS) called [Essential Elements \(EEs\)](#). Blueprints for DLM can be found on the [DLM website](#).

The DLM Science Alternate assessment is designed using principles of Universal Design for Learning (UDL) and delivered through a user interface built especially for this student population.

Students have access to an array of accessibility supports and options for flexibility during test administration to remove potential barriers to their demonstration of knowledge, skills, and understandings in science.

# ACCESS for ELLs Pre-ID File

The ACCESS for ELLs Pre-ID QuickBase application is now open for LEAs to register students for the ACCESS assessments. LEAs will need to:

- verify student demographic information for students taking ACCESS
- indicate required accommodations, if warranted
- indicate which mode of administration is required (online or paper)

Student data can be entered into the QuickBase application on each student's page, utilizing the "grid edit" function, or downloading data as a spreadsheet template and uploading it back into the system.

- For larger LEAs, the template may be downloaded by clicking the "Export" button.
- The template will download to your computer.

# 2019 PARCC and DC Science Administration

- There will be one combined manual for PARCC and DC Science
- PearsonAccessNext (PAN) will include both assessments in the same administrative view
  - The student registration file will include both assessments
  - The personal needs profile (PNP) will include both assessments
  - Test sessions for PARCC and DC Science will be created in the same administrative view
- PARCC and DC Science materials will be ordered in PAN by completing the PNP and using the additional orders function
- DC Science paper-based assessments will need to be transcribed into TestNav8 and will not be shipped to Pearson for scoring
