SUBJECT: Pre-Kindergarten Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS) Evaluation

Pursuant to the Pre-K Enhancement and Expansion Amendment Act of 2008 (D.C. Code 38-271.03; DC Law 17-202), the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) respectfully requests your cooperation in an evaluation of the District of Columbia's universal pre-K program. The purpose of the evaluation is to assess the quality of children's experience in all classrooms using the Classroom Assessment Scoring System for Pre-Kindergarten (CLASS Pre-K), a research-based observational tool.
