

## **PUPIL PERSONNEL WORKER**

- (A) A conferred bachelor's degree from an accredited institution;
- (B) Eighteen (18) semester credits to include the following:
  - (1) Abnormal psychology/psychopathology;
  - (2) Educational psychology;
  - (3) Educational sociology/urban problems/community problems (socio-psycho, economic aspects); and
  - (4) Human development and behavior;
- (C) Fifteen (15) semester hours from the following:
  - (1) Appraisal techniques;
  - (2) Consultation skills/parent community relations/human relations;
  - (3) Counseling theories;
  - (4) Developmental learning/developmental reading/developmental psychology;
  - (5) Legal, legislative and ethical issues; or
  - (6) Survey of exceptional children/survey of special education; and
- (D) One (1) year of satisfactory experience as part of the degree program OR experience in a work setting that deals with the problems of youth.
