

## Overview

This report presents the final 2015-16 enrollment audit results for the students who qualify for the Uniform per Student Funding Formula (UPSFF). In order to be eligible for UPSFF funding, students must be enrolled and attending DC public and public charter schools as of Oct. 5 of the current school year. Therefore, this report does not include nonpublicly placed students, students under the care of Child and Family Services attending surrounding county schools, students enrolled at private or religious organizations, students attending Maya Angelou New Beginnings, or students enrolled in Pre-K Incentive programs.

## Data Field Explanations

**UPSFF grade level:** The UPSFF grade level is the student's grade level for UPSFF funding purposes. In most cases, this grade corresponds with the enrollment grade reported by the school. Students' grade of enrollment may differ from the UPSFF grade for programs with special designations (alternative, adult, or special education) and in cases where a student's grade of enrollment is not a permitted grade value.

**Limited English Proficient:** The percentage of students between the ages of 3 and 21 per the pre-established school age cutoffs dates who are Limited English Proficient (LEP) or Non-English Proficient (NEP) according to the criteria established in No Child Left Behind (NCLB) of 2001 (Public Law 107-110).

**Special Education Levels:** The percentage of students between the ages of 3 and 21 who are eligible to receive special education services as of Oct. 5, **At Risk:** The percentage of students who are considered at risk. Students are considered at risk who are identified as homeless, in the District's foster care system, qualify for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), or are high school students who are one or more years older than the expected age for their grade level. Alternative and Adult designated programs do not qualify for at-risk.

## Other

In instances where fewer than 10 students would be included in a reported category, **less than X%** is displayed. The X% represents the percentage of all students enrolled at the school who are part of that particular subgroup.
