

## **SCHOOL LIBRARIAN / MEDIA SPECIALIST**

(A) A conferred master's degree from an accredited institution; and,

(B) Twenty-one (21) semester hours in library or information science content that includes the following:

(1) Cataloging and classification;

(2) Computerized applications of library automation and information access;

(3) Instructional media design and production;

(4) Organization of school library media programs and collections;

(5) Reference sources and services;

(6) Evaluation, selection and utilization of instructional media for children and young people; and

(7) Integration of library resources in the curriculum; and

(C) Directed field experience in a school library media center with an experienced media specialist; OR two (2) years of successful recognized teaching experience; OR one (1) year of library experience.
