Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Out of School Time Grant Recipients Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-2017

On September 18, 2015 the Office of the State Superintendent of Education's awarded \$6.5 million of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) funding to 17 Out-of-School Time (OST) grantees. The grantees will provide academic enrichment opportunities for low-income students, three to 12 years of age and to 19 years of age for students with special needs, outside of regular school hours and during the summer. The TANF OST program is an important element of an effective system of community supports and services for families and children.
