

## Tree Part Program

The Office of the State Superientendent of Education has partnered with C & D Tree Company to provide the following materials free for DC school gardens:

- Wood Chips\*\* can be used for paths, etc...

- Double Shredded Hardwood Mulch \*\* can be used for non-edible planting beds, paths etc...

- Logs (indicate how many you want and about what size) can be used for seating, path boarders, planting boarders, structures, art, habitat, play structures, etc..

- <u>Stumps</u> (indicate how many you want- no less than 10 and if you want them cut into "chairs") can be used for seating, planting boarders, etc...

\*\*Available in 15 cu yds. ONLY- this is equal to roughly 150 large bags or 8 full pick-up truck loads.

Also available are wood tables. If you would like to place an order, please contact Jack Howard at **jackmhoward@hotmail.com** with the following information:

- 1. The name and cell phone # for the person who will be at the site the day of delivery. This person must be on site when the delivery takes place (see #4).
- 2. The address of the school, and detailed info on where to dump the materials. The most helpful marker is a stick painted orange placed in the location where you want the materials dumped. The location must be accessible for a large dump truck (gates must be 12ft wide).
- 3. What item(s) you are requesting, the quantity of the item if applicable. Mulch and wood chips only come in 15 cubic yard amounts.
- 4. The date you would like delivery to take place Deliveries take place at or before 7am.
