

The Washington Youth Garden

Location – US National Arboretum at Bladensburg Rd. NE, Washington, DC 20002

Field trip season - April through October

Days/times site is open for field trips – Wed, Thurs, Fri 10-11:30 a.m. & 1-2:30 p.m.

Grade levels welcome – Pre-K to 12th grade

Length of field trips - 1 1/2 hours

Travel time from downtown DC - 15 minutes

Student:Chaperone ratio – 7:1

Protocol for inclement weather – Canceled for thunder/heavy rain/excessive mud; decision made jointly with teacher morning of the trip.

Cost of field trip – \$100-200 depending on school population's percent free reduced price meal eligibility.

Lunch – Students can bring their own to eat at on-site picnic tables.

Dress code – Closed-toe shoes and weather appropriate attire.

Type of farm – Teaching

Wheelchair accessible – Yes, although adjustments to the trip may have to be made.

Bathroom on site – Yes
