Title: Campus Wide Wireless

Estimated ARRA Amount: \$450,000.00

Location: Office of Information Technology

Description of Work: In order to align the University's information technology capacity with the administration's vision of a 21st century campus, the Office of Information Technology installed a wireless network throughout the Van Ness campus. This project will allow both students and staff to obtain secure access to campus networks, including library resources and the external Internet, without being confined to specific buildings or areas. The project was completed on September 30, 2011.

The network will implement an 802.11n wireless network using Cisco Wireless Technology. The turnkey solution provides wireless network access in all areas of the campus (indoor and outdoor) including: buildings 32, 38, 39, 41, 42, 44, 46E, 46W, 47, Cleveland Dennard Plaza and the Amphitheater. The network provides 100% internal and external coverage and standardized CISCO interfaces.
