Please provide **confidential** and specific information regarding your nominee on the enclosed form. All questions must be answered, preferably typewritten. Please include a one-page narrative with this form that addresses how the candidate meets the criteria mentioned in this letter, and a resume from their personnel file (if available). We ask that you keep this recommendation confidential and do not share it with the individual/s you nominate. If necessary, please assign the request to relevant staff that would be able to assist with generating pool candidates.
