- Transferable skills
- Personal and work values
- Work history and work skills
- Educational interests
- Preferred working conditions
- Financial and family needs
- Time and resources they can invest





Why INTEGRATE career awareness

- 1. Helps with engagement and persistence
- 2. Simultaneously achieve academic objectives
- 3. Aids in program-wide approach to student support
- 4. Students can enter at any phase
- 5. Students at any level can engage

3 ways to integrate career awareness



While building academic and language objectives



While developing essential workplace and personal skills



Throughout programming and with students at all levels

1. Integrate career awareness *while building academic and language objectives*



Example 1: ESOL Read a description of the qualities of a childcare provider in a parenting unit. Teach personal qualities vocabulary. Teach adjectives while you discuss which qualities you possess. ex. I am organized"

2. Integrate career awareness *while developing essential workplace and personal skills*



Example: *"Assign students to work in teams to develop a presentation about each other's jobs. Define teamwork and presentation skills. Have students reflect on their own teamwork and presentation skills. "*

3. Integrate career awareness *throughout programming and with students at all levels*



Example:

"Share the vocabulary used in student self-exploration activities with all staff to establish program-wide terminology."
