

# **FY20 Browne EC Eligible Services**

- (1) Programs designed to increase attendance, including reducing early chronic absenteeism**
  - (2) Youth development programs designed to promote social, emotional, physical and moral development, including arts, sports, physical fitness, leadership, community service, and service learning opportunities**
  - (3) Programs designed to facilitate parental involvement in, and engagement with, their children's education, including parental activities that involve supporting, monitoring, and advocating for their children's education; and programs designed to promote parental leadership in the life of the school and build parenting skills**
  - (4) Youth and adult job-training services, career exploration and counseling services.**
